PREFACE

The Cholera Research Laboratory (CRL) operates under a bilateral project agreement between the Governments of Bangladesh and the United States of America. Research activities of CRL center on the interrelationships between diarrheal disease, nutrition, fertility and their environmental determinants. CRL issues two types of papers: scientific reports and working papers which demonstrate the type of research activity currently in progress at CRL. Under its special publication series, CRL has endeavoured to publish this chronological bibliography entitled Index to CRL Publications and Scientific Presentations, 1960-1976. This bibliography is divided into 2 parts, followed by author and subject indexes. Part 1 includes published monographs, reports and periodical articles covering the period from 1961 to 1976. Part 2 includes scientific papers, both published and unpublished, presented at different seminars, congresses, conferences, meetings and training courses covering the period from 1960 to 1976. Most of the published materials are available in the CRL Library.
