How can we counter the negative effect of poverty on early child development?

Poverty prevents an estimated 219 million children under the age of five in low- and middle-income countries from reaching their full developmental potential, and negatively impacts their health. A new icddr,b study examines how poverty affects the development of key cognitive abilities in the early years of life and shows that factors such as parental education, early childhood growth and home stimulation may counter the influence of poverty.


